

Finding a Fit

- A Fit is 8+ cards in one suit
 between the two hands
- If there is a fit in a **major** suit, then this will be the trump suit
- If there is no fit, then choose
 NoTrumps





Levels of Bidding

- The number of tricks you must make to get a score = 6 + the level you bid
 - 1-level contracts ... Must make 7 tricks (6 + 1)
 - 2-level contracts ... Must make 8 tricks (6 + 2)
 - 3-level Contracts ... Must make tricks (6 + 3) etc
 - 4-level Contracts ... Must make

• 6-level Contracts ... Must make

The Auction

- Every suit has a ranking order
- Each bid must be higher than the previous bid

1*	1 ♦	1♥	1 🔺	1NT
2*	2 ♦	2 💙	2 🛧	2NT
3*	3 🔶	3 🗸	3♠	3NT
4 🌲	4 🔶	4♥	4 🛧	4NT
		etc		

- The first person to bid is the Opener
- Opener's partner is the Responder


Basic Rules for Opening I-suit

• You must have enough High Card Points






Basic Rules for Opening I-suit






Opener's First Bid

	Points	Description	
14	12 - 19	4 + clubs	
1 🔶	12 – 19	4 + diamonds	
1 🗸	12 – 19	4 + hearts	
14	12 – 19	4 + spades	
1NT	12 – 14	Balanced hand (SPECIAL CASE)	



Rules for I-level suit openings


Bid your longest suit first





Basic Rules for I-level suit openings

Bid your lower ranking **4-card** suit first





What do you open?

Bid your higher ranking **5-card** suit first







Open I & ... open your Iower ranking 4-card suit first











Open I A ... open your higher ranking 5-card suit first



Further Bidding ... To come in more detail

- **Responder** needs 6 + points to bid (At least ½ of what Opener needs)
- Try to find a **Fit** as soon as possible
- There are 3 choices of level to bid to:
 - 1. Minimum (6 9)
 - 2. Close to Game (10 12)
 - 3. Enough for Game (13+)



- If there is NO fit, then bid NoTrumps
- To bid **Game** you need **25+** points between the two hands



Summary for I-level suit openers


- Open with <u>12-19 points</u>
- Bid your <u>longest</u> suit first



- If you have <u>two 4-card suits</u> bid the lower ranked suit first
- If you have <u>two 5-card suits</u> bid the <u>higher ranked suit first</u>
- Suit quality does not matter
