Balanced Hands



Opener's First Bid

	Points	Description
*	12 - 19	4 + clubs
	12 – 19	4 + diamonds
	12 – 19	4 + hearts
	12 – 19	4 + spades
INT	12 – 14	Balanced hand SPECIAL CASE



Basic Rules for Opening INT

- 12 14 points
- Balanced Hand

This bid is your FIRST choice from now on



What is a balanced hand?

- No singleton or void
- No more than I doubleton
- No 5-card major
- Balanced = 4333, 4432, 2335 shape

Balanced hands are the most common



What does responder decide to do?

- Have you got enough points to bid or invite to game?
- If so do you want to play in NoTrumps or a suit?

Responder is the BOSS There are ONLY 2 decisions to make



Responses to INT - Balanced Hand

- 0 10 points so no GAME possible PASS
- 11 12 points so GAME is possible Bid 2NT
- 13+ points so GAME ON Bid 3NT

Add your points
to partner's
KNOWN 12-14 points

Responder BIDS 3NT

you jointly have enough HCP for GAME



Responder's hand shown below.... 12 HCP







Responder BIDS 2NT

Responder's hand shown below.... 12 HCP



Bid 2NT

you have almost enough HCP for GAME. Depends if opener has 12,13 or 14



Responses to INT open and Responder has an Unbalanced Hand

If you have 0-10 points, GAME is not possible, so...

Bid your card suit at the 2-level

This is called a WEAK TAKEOUT

Partner MUST then pass ... YOU ARE THE BOSS

Add your points to partner's KNOWN 12-14 points



Responses to INT open and Responder has an Unbalanced Hand

12+ points ... GAME Forcing



• Bid your Sour Card MAJOR at the 3-level

(Opener MUST agree your suit or bid NoTrumps)



• Bid your card MAJOR at the 4-level

card MINOR at the 5-level

Bid 2 Not enough for GAME

Opener MUST pass

Bid 4 Enough for GAME AND a known fit in spades

Q: Why is this fit guaranteed?



Responder's hand shown below.... 14 HCP and 5♥







Responder's hand shown below.... 13 HCP and 6 •



Bid 3 Fenough for GAME <u>BUT</u> need to check if there is a heart fit

Opener chooses 3NT or bids 4 v if they have a fit
