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## Lesson 4.5

Recap on Responder's Bidding



How many HCP are required to OPEN? <u>12-19</u>

How many HCP are required to RESPOND? <u>6+</u>

How many cards of same suit MUST you have between your hands to have a FIT??

As Responder you can SUPPORT or you can bid A NEW SUIT or you can bid NO TRUMPS





If you choose to SUPPORT PARTNER'S SUIT, the rules are:

- Minimum HCP (6-9) ... bid at the 2-level
- Nearly game HCP (10-12) ... bid at the 3-level
- Game HCP (13+) ... bid at the Game level

These are **LIMIT BIDS** – you are telling your partner you like the suit they bid (confirming a fit) and telling them HOW MANY POINTS you have within a range THEN LET THEM DECIDE WHAT HAPPENS NEXT



If you choose to BID A NEW SUIT, the rules are:

- Your HCP (6+) ... bid new suit at the I-level
- Your HCP (10+) ... bid new suit at the 2-level

These are **FORCING BIDS** – you are telling your partner you DON'T like the suit they bid (possibly no fit) and telling them HOW MANY POINTS you have with lower range, unlimited upper range

#### THEN LET THEM DECIDE WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

Note: they MUST and WILL BID AGAIN because you forced them



#### Which suit do you bid first?

- I. Longest suit
- 2. Lower ranking of two 4-card suits
- 3. Higher ranking of two 5-card suits

These are UNLIMITED **FORCING BIDS** – you are telling your partner you DON'T like the suit they bid (possibly no fit) and telling them HOW MANY POINTS you have with lower range, unlimited upper range

#### THEN LET THEM DECIDE WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

Note: they MUST and WILL BID AGAIN because you forced them



Remembering the difference between a **LIMIT BID** and a **FORCING BID** is extremely important.

It makes the difference between stopping before you get in too deep (PASS is the hardest bid to make) AND getting to GAME level where you get a good score

What does Opener bid next?

I was a FORCING BID

Opener REBIDS 3 ... why? Opener has 4 so there is a FIT

**Recall Lesson 3 Opener Rebid choices:** 

Min HCP (12-15) PASS Close to Game HCP (16-17) INVITE Game HCP (18-19) Bid GAME

What did Responder tell Opener?

"Partner, I can't give you a ♥ fit, however I have 6+ points and at least 4♠"

What does Opener bid next?

I \* was a FORCING BID

Opener REBIDS 2... why?

Opener can bid 2. to show a second suit and has 12-15 HCP, also opener was forced to bid because of the suit change by responder.

Opener knows there is minimum 19 points between the hands. Responder can figure out minimum point count also.

What did Responder tell Opener?

"Partner, I can't give you a ♥ fit, however I have 10+ points and at least 4.\*"

What does Opener bid next?

2\* was a FORCING BID

Opener REBIDS 3... why?

Opener can support \$\ \\$ so bids 3\$\ \\$ to show there is a FIT and has 12-15 HCP, also opener was forced to bid because of the suit change by responder. Opener now knows there is minimum 23 points between the hands. Responder can figure out minimum point count also.

"Partner, I can't give you a ♥ fit, however I have 10+ points and at least 4 ♦"

What does Opener bid next?

2 • was a FORCING BID

Opener REBIDS 3♥ ... why?

#### **Recall Lesson 4 Opener Rebid choices:**

Min HCP (12-15) PASS
Close to Game HCP (16-17) INVITE
Game HCP (18-19) Bid GAME
Opener rebids their own suit if they have

6+ cards of that suit, shortage of ◆



#### **Hand 7 Scenario D**

19

Opener Bids I •

Responder Bids I 🕶

What did Responder tell Opener?

"Partner, I can't give you a ♦ fit, however I have 6+ points and at least 4♥"

What does Opener bid next?

I was a FORCING BID

Opener REBIDS 3NT ... why?

Opener has 19 HCP. Knows that Partner has minimum 6 HCP... 19+6 is 25 HCP. "You know, you go"

Opener has stopper card in ♠ and ♣.

<b>•</b>	KQ943
*	AJ

How many HCP?

15

Opener Bids I •

Responder Bids I 🕶

What did Responder tell Opener?

"Partner, I can't give you a ♦ fit however I have 6+ points and at least 4♥"

What does Opener bid next?

I was a FORCING BID

Opener REBIDS I ♠ ... why?

Opener cannot support ♥ but has 4♠ Opener can show their other 4 card suit, in this case it is ♠.
